
Adjusting the Full Length True Mirror

- 0) The right hand screw knob (1) controls the whole right panel, whereas the left side screw knobs (2-5) control just the 8" section that is at that position
- 1) Always start with looking and adjusting the center 12 inches using the RIGHT panel knob. Once that is aligned, go to each of the LEFT panel knobs and match it to that setting, using knobs 2-5
- 2) Repeat adjusting knobs 1-5 at least once to really fine tune.
- 3) Confirm it is adjusted by running your eye from top to bottom in the seam, objects in the distance will be clear. Also, if you stand back 10 feet, it will be clear.
- 4) To actually adjust each knob: Locate the section to adjust with your eyes. Look for objects in the distance that are light/dark diagonal. If the seam is out of alignment, its easy to see it with this kind of angled line. Turn knob at current position to get the diagonal line clear.



Step 1 - Always do this first align this section before any others.

Note: the right hand screw controls the entire right panel, but always focus on the middle 12" section. Get this right and then the other side gets aligned to match this.
